From 2014 he developed a translational research program on rare pulmonary diseases in collaboration with the Institute of basic science and noprofit foundation INGM (Istituto Nazionale di Genetica Molecolare director Prof. Sergio Abrignani).

Since 2004 he has developed a collaboration with the NIH (director dr. Joel Moss) on LAM with several papers published.

Prof. Harari leads his research in the field of rare pulmonary diseases, focusing on the diagnosis and development of clinical trials. He is interested in the study of Idiopathic Pulmonary Fibrosis (IPF) and his research have allowed an improvement in its diagnostic path and in the management of its complications even in association to different comorbidities. Furthermore, the prognostic role of prognostic markers has been investigated. Prof. Harari has been involved in several randomized clinical trials about IPF new treatment, included pivotal clinical trials of pirfenidone and nintedanib, both have been first drugs available for the treatment of IPF. In collaboration with the research centre of the National Health Service of the University Bicocca (Milan, Italy), Prof. Harari developed epidemiological study in order to investigate the incidence and the prevalence of IPF in Lombardia region, as well as its correlation with pollution. In addiction, in collaboration with the main Italian interstitial lung disease centres, he is leading research collecting real life data in order to evaluate the efficacy of antifibrotic treatment. Prof. Harari is an international leader since several decades in the research on cystic lung diseases (i.e. PLCH, LAM) and PH associated to ILD. More recently he published several epidemiological and clinical studies on SARS COV-2 pandemic and post Covid condition in collaboration with the Instituto Mario Negri and with other Italian institutions.

Prof. Harari serves since 2006 years as columnist of the most important Italian newspaper the "Corriere della Sera"

Since 2012 he also established a website on respiratory medicine for doctors, patients and citizens, named "il polmone" (the lung in Italian, www.ilpolmone.it) containing also a video section, with actually more than 25.000 visitors per month and more than 70.000 per month during the pandemic.

Prof. Harari founded in 2012 the no-profit association "Peripato" to promote culture, science and health in Italy.
